Inspired by African-American quilters and artists such as Nancy Crow, Pam turned to making quilts out of old clothes, i.e. "britches quilts," when her children were in their rough and tumble teenage years.

She'll show some small-scale samples she made before attempting bigger quilts and give tips for making your own quilt design. Some options: string quilts; combining different-sized blocks of the same pattern; combining blocks of different patterns; using traditional blocks made wonky or much larger than usual ... or something entirely of your own design.

### **Supplies Participants Should Bring:**

- Sewing machine (with cords, bobbins, thread)
- Walking foot
- Heavy duty sewing machine needles such as Jeans 100/16 or 110/18
- Rotary mat and rotary cutter with sharp blade
- Basic sewing supplies
- Corduroy: Pam will bring her large and varied supply of corduroy. You are encouraged to drop by your local thrift store to select additional pieces and colors to add to your quilt and to share.
