The sky is, literally, the limit with this playful and freewheeling technique. No fusing or sewing machines necessary for this fun class. Just bring your favorite photograph for inspiration and the supplies listed below.

Plan to work small enough to finish your collage in one day. Meri will show you how to add borders to make the quilt any size. Then, machine quilt the outside edges of the project. “Come play with me!” states Meri.

Supplies Participants Should Bring:

- A photo, sketch or design idea for inspiration
- Scissors
- Fabric in colors that will complement your picture
- Batting the size you want your project to be
- Backing fabric the same size as the batting
- Black tulle the same size as the batting to cover your project
- Various embellishments for special effects. For example: yarn, trim, beads, buttons, feathers, sequins, other colors of tulle, etc.
- Lots of straight or safety pins!
- A playful attitude!
- **SEWING MACHINES ARE NOT NEEDED!!!**
- Optional: Light weight Wonder-Under or similar stabilizer
