**SAIL INTO THE NEW YEAR ON
"THE SHIP OF MY DREAMS"**

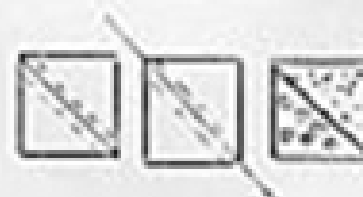
This Sailing Ship pattern has been a favorite among quilters for many years (and under many names).

Construct your ship with white sails and blue sky - or red sails in the sunset - or slowboat to China . . .



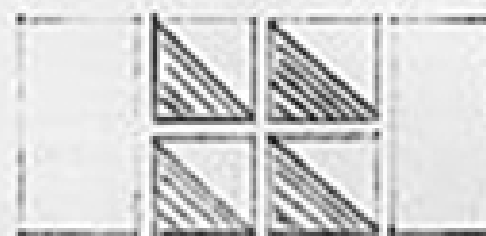
Constructed in 3 rows, for the first row,

Cut one 3-7/8" square each of the sail and sky fabric.
Right sides together, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on the light square. Sew 1/4" from the line on both sides and then cut on the line. Repeat once.
Cut two 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" of sky fabric.
Assemble as shown.



For the second row,

Cut one 3-7/8" square of the boat and water fabric.
Sew as above.
Cut one 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" boat fabric.
Assemble as shown.



For the third row,

Cut one 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece of the water fabric.



Now, lay out your pieces and assemble the rows as shown.
Your Sailing Ship block should measure 12-1/2" square.
