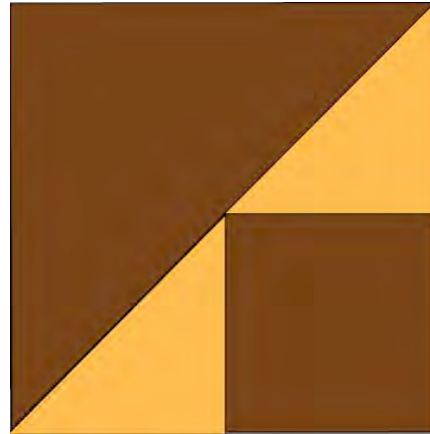


## **Block of the Month for November: Bird in the Air 10" finished**

I recommend paper piecing this block for precision in piecing and size. Paper piecing pattern will be available at October meeting.

### **Fabrics:**

one of cranberry/burgundy, rust, forest green, deep purple, orange, or gold -and- one dark cream, beige or tan fabric; stripes and plaids are especially good.



Cut from dark fabric, one 11" square and one 5" square;  
divide 11" square diagonally into two triangles (one extra).  
Cut from beige or tan fabric, one light 5-3/4" square;  
cut diagonally into two triangles.

Attach one light triangle to each of two adjacent sides of small dark square; attach resulting triangular unit to large dark triangle.  
Use scant seam allowance.
