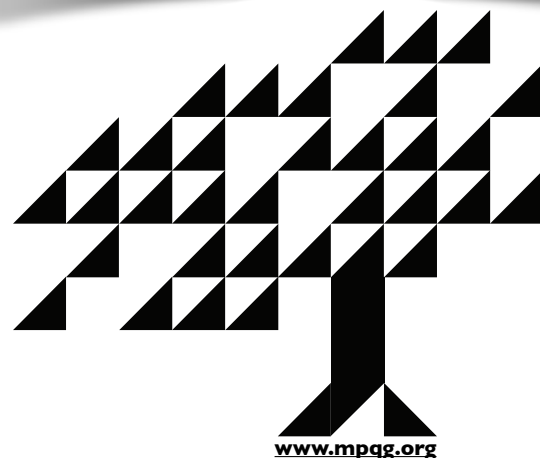

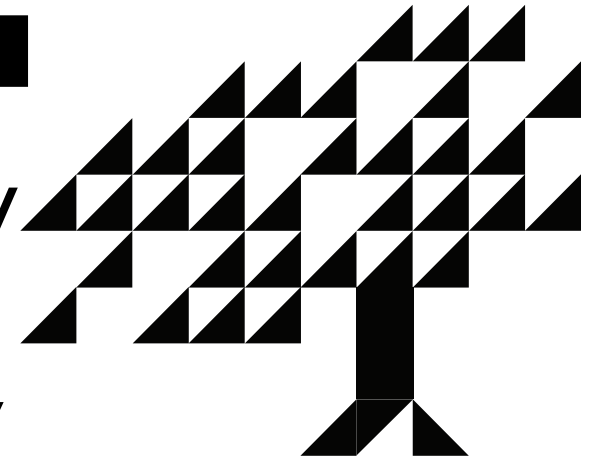

Monterey Peninsula Quilters Guild (MPQG) was founded in 1979 and is an all-volunteer, 501(c)(3) organization. Its members are not only artists, but generous givers. Over the years our Community Outreach program has donated thousands of quilts. In just the past year, over 400 quilted items were donated to those in need. These gifts range from heart-shaped and port pillows to dialysis, tummy-time, crib, youth, and bed quilts. Our Grants Program donates the money we raise from raffle tickets to local schools and organizations to help them promote quilting and sewing activities.

Guild membership has many benefits: fiber art experts as guest speakers at our monthly meetings and scheduled workshops, quilting bees, our annual quilt show, friendship quilt groups, and much more. We meet either in-person at the Pacific Grove Community Center at 515 Junipero Street, Pacific Grove, or on Zoom, or both, usually on the 1st Monday of the month. Social time starts at 6:30 PM followed by our meeting at 7:00 PM. Guests are welcome for a fee of \$5.00. Membership is \$40 (September to August). All quilting levels are welcomed and invited!
