

Turned Corners



This block uses three fabrics.

Fabric A – cut 1 piece 9” square

Fabric B – cut 2 pieces 10 x 2” and 2 pieces 14 x 2”

Fabric C – cut 2 pieces 1 x 13” and 2 pieces 1 x 18”

Attach the 10 x 2 pieces to opposite sides of the 9” square.

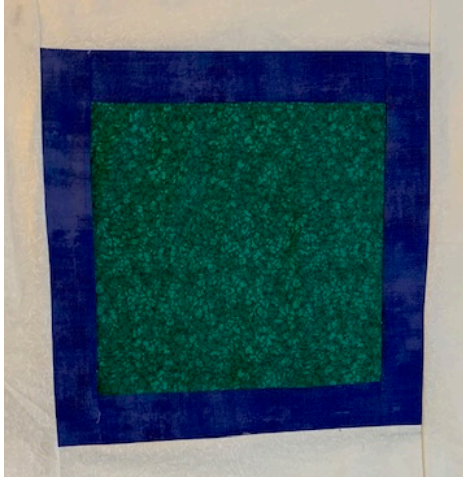
Attach the 14 x 2 pieces to the remaining 2 sides of the square

Press toward center

Attach the 1 x 13 pieces to opposite sides of the pressed square

Attach the 1 x 18 pieces to the remaining 2 sides of the pressed square. Press toward center.

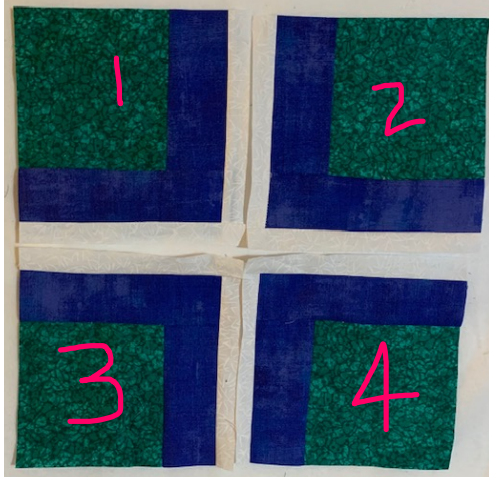
You will have a square with double framing.



Cut the square in equal quarters



Rotate the quarters 180 degrees so that fabric C is in the center of the block



Sew the quarters together. 1 to 2, and 3 to 4. Press the seam between 1 and 2 to the right and the seam between 3 and 4 to the left. Sew the two units together. Press and trim to 12"
