
opened up a new world and led to constantly improving on the

ZOOM Workshop with Trudy Cleveland


"How To Photograph Your Quilts Like a Pro"

Back by popular demand! We will be collecting donations to do another online auction this fall, right before the holidays. In addition to mini-quilts and pincushions, quilters can create festive fall or winter decorations and items that would make great gifts.

Auction Item Categories:

- 1. Wall hangings and mini quilts
- 2. Pincushions
- 3. Table runners, placemats, potholders and mug rugs
- 4. Tree skirts, quilted ornaments, stockings and holiday decorations
- 5. Other quilted items and gifts
- 6. Handcrafted items and gifts (Allows for other fiber arts and creations, but keep in mind that we may have to ship items, so please keep their size and weight down.)

The items need to be turned in no later than November 13th. The auction will likely be held November 20th through November 30th (the exact dates will be confirmed as we get closer). We will send out email notifications with times and locations for drop-offs.

The Fall Quilt Action Fundraiser will use the more traditional bidding process rather than the proxy bidding system. This means the amount you submit will be your bid - the system will not update it for you. However, you can be notified by text or email if you are out-bid so you can increase your bid.

The challenge is still the same: Produce a quilt 18"x18" that is at least 80% dominated by shades of one color.

Add to your virtual submission:

- your name
- · name of quilt
- pattern name or inspiration if applicable.

As we do hope to show them in person eventually, the quilt label should have:

- Your name
- · Name of the Quilt
- 2020 MPQG Challenge
- And a 4" sleeve for hanging.
