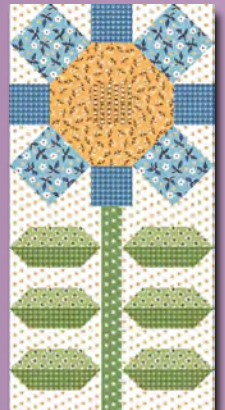

Show Off Our Community Outreach

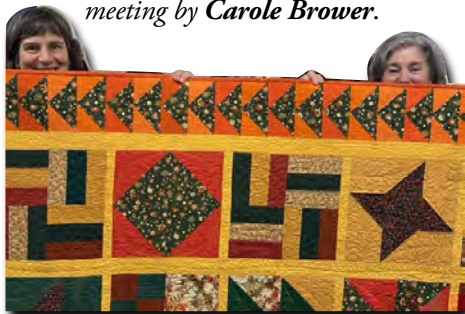

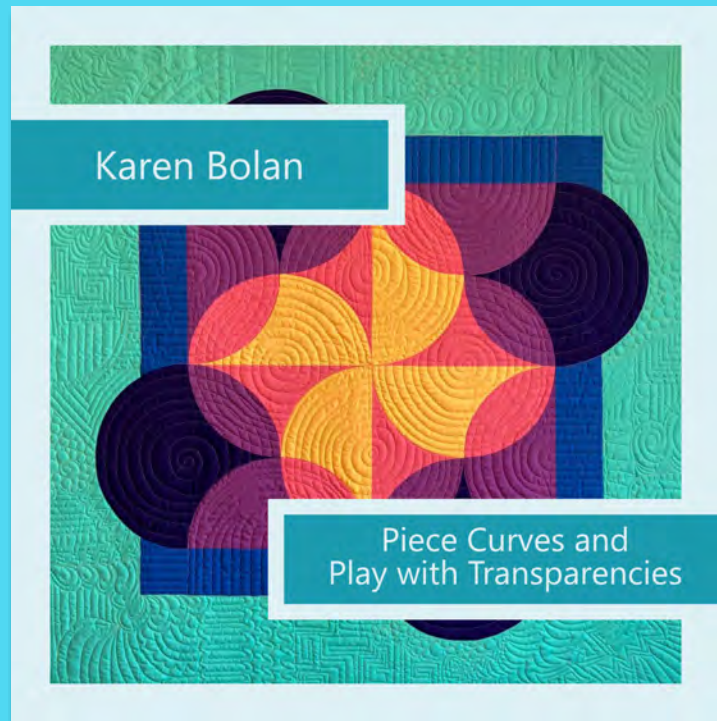

Piece Curves and Play with Transparency

Are you intimidated by curves but love precision piecing? Start the *Cool as a Cactus* quilt in class, featuring pieced curves, a unique border treatment, and a color palette that features transparency. Class will begin with an exercise in creating transparency effect. Then we work from paper templates to accurately cut and piece large diameter curves. Learn to cut and precisely piece large-diameter curves from templates, assemble a quilt top with pieced borders, and plan a color palette that includes a transparency effect. Students must purchase the digital pattern. Leave class with at least one block and border complete.

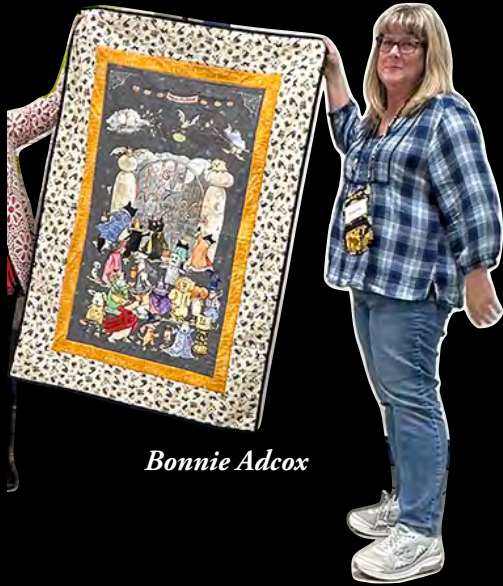

Put Your Stamp on It!

2025 MPQG Annual Quilt Challenge

Size: 18"x20" (portrait or landscape)

Quilts must have:

- 3 layers (top, batting, backing)
- 4" sleeve for hanging and label* on back
- a postage stamp border

Due Date: August 4th Guild Meeting

Quilts may be inspired by vintage stamps, forever stamps, foreign stamps, or your own design. Postage stamp border can be done by hand or by the Alison Glass Method using AG Stamp Stripe Fabric. Use your creativity!

Quilts will be displayed at the August Guild meeting, the 2025 Monterey County Fair and at the 2026 MPQG quilt show where they may be judged, if you so choose.

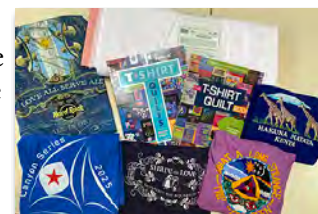
