Big T Origami

- Use two fabrics, plus a contrasting background fabric
- Cut a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " from one of the fabrics
- From the other fabric, cut 2 5 x 5 " squares and 8 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- From the background fabric, cut 2 5 " squares and 8 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- Match a colored 5 " square to a background 5 " square.
- Draw a diagonal line
- Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the diagonal
- Cut along the diagonal.
- Repeat with the other pair of 5 " squares
- Press to the light, you will have 4 half square triangles,
- Trim to $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square
- Place a colored $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square at one end of a white rectangle. Sew diagonally across the colored square. Trim outside the stitching line.
- Repeat at the other end of the rectangle. Make sure the colored fabrics overlap in the center
- Press to the dark – you have made flying geese!

- Sew your flying goose to a background rectangle. To preserve the 'beak' of the goose, make your seam go exactly through the intersection. Press.
